ON

“APPROVAL OF THE INTERNAL REGULATION ON THE ORGANIZATION AND
FUNCTIONING OF THE AUTHORITY OF ELECTRONIC AND POSTAL
COMMUNICATIONS (AKEP)”

The Steering Council (SC) of the Authority of Electronic and Postal Communications (AKEP), with the participation of:

and Secretary Ms. Dania Nallbani, at the meeting held on 31.03.2026, conducted in accordance with the procedures set out in Law No. 54/2024 “On Electronic Communications in the Republic of Albania” and Law No. 8480, dated 27.05.1999 “On the functioning of collegial bodies of the state administration and public entities”, upon proposal of the Directorate of Human Resources and External Relations, reviewed the matter with the subject:

“Approval of the internal regulation on the organization and functioning of the Authority of Electronic and Postal Communications (AKEP)”

LEGAL BASIS:

Pursuant to Law No. 54/2024 “On Electronic Communications in the Republic of Albania” and Law No. 8480, dated 27.05.1999 “On the functioning of collegial bodies of the state administration and public entities”, as well as in implementation of the legislation in force governing the organization and functioning of public administration, employment relations, rules of ethics, the right to information, document administration, and the prevention of conflicts of interest, in accordance with the principles of good administration and the efficient functioning of independent institutions.

THE STEERING COUNCIL:

Following the review of the written materials:

- The reasoned draft decision;
- The explanatory report accompanying the draft decision;

as well as the discussions held during the meeting on the matter, and referring to the above-mentioned legal basis,

NOTES:

1. With the entry into force of Law No. 54, dated 30.05.2024 “On Electronic Communications in the Republic of Albania”, AKEP is obliged to update and approve its internal acts governing the organization and functioning of the institution, in accordance with the new legal provisions and institutional developments.
2. The Resolution of the Assembly of Albania on AKEP’s activity and the recommendations for 2025 require the institution to continue the process of drafting and approving secondary legislation in implementation of Law No. 54/2024.
3. The Directorate of Human Resources and External Relations has analyzed AKEP’s existing internal regulations and, with the aim of harmonizing them with the legislation in force and the organizational structure, has drafted the new regulation.
4. The new regulation aims at the full harmonization of internal rules governing the activity of the Steering Council as a collegial body and the AKEP administration at the executive level with the changes in the applicable legislation, ensuring a clear division of competences and responsibilities of each structure.
5. In accordance with the principle of institutional autonomy established by law, AKEP exercises its right to adopt internal acts regulating its organization and functioning.

FOR THESE REASONS:

Based on point 1 of Article 14 of Law No. 54/2024 “On Electronic Communications in the Republic of Albania”, the Steering Council of AKEP,

DECIDED:

1. To approve the “Internal Regulation on the organization and functioning of the Authority of Electronic and Postal Communications (AKEP)”, according to the document attached to this decision.
2. Steering Council Decision No. 7, dated 16.02.2017, Internal Regulation “On the functioning of the Steering Council of AKEP”, as amended, and Steering Council Decision No. 6, dated 16.02.2017, Internal Regulation “On the functioning of the AKEP administration”, as amended, are hereby repealed.
3. The entire organizational structure of AKEP is entrusted with the implementation of the obligations arising from this decision, in accordance with the area of responsibility of each unit.

This decision enters into force immediately.
