DECISION

No. 15, dated 28.05.2026

ON
“APPROVAL OF THE REGULATION
ON THE INSPECTION OF THE ACTIVITIES OF UNDERTAKINGS PROVIDING
ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS NETWORKS AND SERVICES”

The Steering Council (SC) of the Electronic and Postal Communications Authority (AKEP), attended by:

and with Ms. Dania Nallbani acting as Secretary, at the meeting held on 28 May 2026, in accordance with the procedure established by Law No. 54/2024 “On Electronic Communications in the Republic of Albania”, Law No. 8480, dated 27.05.1999 “On the Functioning of Collegial Bodies of State Administration and Public Entities”, and the Internal Regulation on the Organization and Functioning of the Electronic and Postal Communications Authority (AKEP), approved by Decision No. 11, dated 31.03.2026, of the AKEP Steering Council, upon the proposal of the Directorate for Consumer Protection, Statistics and Control, examined the matter concerning:

- Approval of the Regulation “On the Inspection of the Activities of Undertakings Providing Electronic Communications Networks and Services”.

LEGAL BASIS:

1. Article 181, paragraph 4, and Article 183, paragraph 3, of Law No. 54/2024 “On Electronic Communications in the Republic of Albania”.

THE STEERING COUNCIL:

Having examined the documentary file consisting of:

1. The Regulation “On the Inspection of the Activities of Undertakings Providing Electronic Communications Networks and Services”, together with Annex 1 “Methodology for the Calculation of Administrative Fines”;
2. AKEP’s Position on the comments received regarding the draft act;
3. The explanatory report accompanying the Draft Decision;
4. The drafted and reasoned Decision;

and following the discussions held during the meeting on the matter, and with reference to the legal basis cited above,

NOTES THAT:

1. Law No. 54/2024 “On Electronic Communications in the Republic of Albania” entered into force on 20 December 2024, repealing Law No. 9918/2008 “On Electronic Communications in the Republic of Albania”, as amended. The new Law No. 54/2024 partially transposes into national legislation Directive (EU) 2018/1972 of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the European Electronic Communications Code (EECC).
2. By Decision No. 28, dated 14.11.2025, the AKEP Steering Council approved for public consultation the document “On the Inspection of the Activities of Undertakings Providing Electronic Communications Networks and Services”. The document was published for public consultation on AKEP’s official website during the period from 17.11.2025 to 16.12.2025. Furthermore, by Decision No. 4, dated 02.02.2026, the AKEP Steering Council approved for public consultation the document “On the Methodology for the Calculation of Administrative Fines”. The public consultation process was conducted over a 30-day period and concluded on 05.03.2026.
3. Upon completion of the public consultation process for the two aforementioned draft acts, AKEP received comments from interested parties, as follows:
 - By letter No. 1746 Prot., dated 10.12.2025, submitted by Vodafone Albania sh.a., regarding the draft act “On the Inspection of the Activities of Undertakings Providing Electronic Communications Networks and Services”;
 - By electronic communication dated 27.02.2026, submitted by Vodafone Albania sh.a., regarding the document “On the Methodology for the Calculation of Administrative Fines”;
 - By letter No. 537 Prot., dated 06.03.2026, submitted by One Albania sh.a., regarding the document “On the Methodology for the Calculation of Administrative Fines”.
4. Following the comments received, AKEP prepared its official position on such comments, as well as the final version of the Regulation.
5. The final draft act “On the Inspection of the Activities of Undertakings Providing Electronic Communications Networks and Services” is fully consistent with AKEP’s legal and institutional obligations as provided under Article 181 and subsequent provisions of

Law No. 54/2024 and Law No. 99/2024, which entrust AKEP with responsibility for supervising, monitoring and ensuring compliance with the regulatory framework in the field of electronic communications.

6. The draft act fulfils AKEP's obligation to adopt secondary legislation and methodologies necessary for the effective exercise of its inspection functions, including the establishment of inspection procedures and the methodology for imposing administrative fines.
7. AKEP considers that, given that the two acts regulate matters that are closely interrelated, it is appropriate to consolidate them into a single act in order to enhance regulatory clarity and avoid regulatory fragmentation.

FOR THESE REASONS:

Pursuant to Article 14(1) and Article 15(1) of Law No. 54/2024 "On Electronic Communications in the Republic of Albania", and Law No. 8480, dated 27.05.1999 "On the Functioning of Collegial Bodies of State Administration and Public Entities", the AKEP Steering Council,

DECIDES:

1. To approve the Regulation "On the Inspection of the Activities of Undertakings Providing Electronic Communications Networks and Services", together with Annex 1 "Methodology for the Calculation of Administrative Fines" as an integral part thereof, as well as the document "AKEP's Position on the Comments of Interested Parties", in accordance with the attached documents.
2. This Decision and the Regulation "On the Inspection of the Activities of Undertakings Providing Electronic Communications Networks and Services" shall be published on AKEP's website at www.akep.al.
3. The AKEP administration is entrusted with the implementation and enforcement of this Decision.

This Decision shall enter into force immediately.
